



## Terms and Conditions – Cambrian Coast Sportive

By entering an event with Welsh Cycling Events, you are agreeing to be bound by the following conditions:

### Rider behaviour

- I agree to abide by the Bye Laws and Technical Regulations of British Cycling.
- I am participating in the event entirely at my own risk and am wholly responsible for dealing with any hazards that I encounter, just as I would on any ride I undertake whether on my own or as part of an organised event.
- I will ensure that my bike and all other equipment are fit for purpose.
- I shall wear properly affixed protective headgear which must be of a hard/soft shell construction.
- I will ride in a manner that is considerate and sporting to others on the ride.
- I am aware that when riding on a public highway the function of marshals is only to indicate direction and that I must decide whether the movement is safe.
- I agree that Welsh Cycling Events, event sponsor, British Cycling or any event official will be in any way responsible or have any liability for circumstances of injury, loss or damage suffered by me in or by reason of the event however caused.
- I will not drop any litter on any part of the route except for in designated rubbish bins at the feed stations. You are riding in Snowdonia National Park where it is a criminal offence to drop litter.
- I will not urinate in public view along the ride.
- I have read and agree to abide by the above declarations.

### Booking

- Events fees are paid as part of the booking process. They are not refundable, deferrable or transferable to another rider.
- If you wish to change your chosen route, you may do so by contacting the Event Office on [events@welshcyclingevents.co.uk](mailto:events@welshcyclingevents.co.uk) . Any additional fees will need to be paid before a route change can be made. In the event that the new chosen route is cheaper than the booked route, no refund will be given for a change in route.
